

## Lenten Study

How do we walk with Christ—daily follow him, grow in him, and faithfully serve him? In the Gospels, Jesus modeled for us the Christian spiritual life. The apostles taught it in their writings. And the Church has, through the last 2,000 years, sought to pursue this Christian spiritual life.

In *The Walk*, Adam Hamilton focuses on five essential spiritual practices that are rooted in Jesus' own walk with God and taught throughout the New Testament. Each of these practices is intended as part of our daily walk with Christ while also being an essential part of growing together in the church.

In each chapter, Hamilton explores one of these practices, its New Testament foundation, and what it looks like to pursue this practice both daily in our personal life and together in the life of the church. # A Message from Mars

<sup>28</sup> One of the teachers of the law came and heard them debating. Noticing that Jesus had given them a good answer, he asked him, “Of all the commandments, which is the most important?”

<sup>29</sup> “The most important one,” answered Jesus, “is this: ‘Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. <sup>30</sup> Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.’<sup>[a]</sup> <sup>31</sup> The second is this: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’<sup>[b]</sup> There is no commandment greater than these.”

--Mark 12:28-31 (New International Version)

In the weeks leading up through the inauguration of President Joe Biden, I prayed for a triumph of democracy, civility, and celebration. I was anxious, but until the inauguration concluded peacefully, I did not realize how much stress I had been feeling. When our new president and vice president had been safely sworn into office – without any of the violence that had been feared – I felt my entire body relax. I praised God that things had gone smoothly. That nonviolent inauguration is just the start of what I suspect will be a long healing process for our nation. I hope you will join me in continuing to lift up our country in prayer in the days and weeks to come.

As we head into February, three upcoming events can inform our behavior both as citizens and as Christians. Two of these – Ash Wednesday and Lent – are important in the Christian calendar; the third is Valentine’s Day, a sappy manmade holiday.

Ash Wednesday reminds us of our own fallibility and mortality and prompts us to pursue repentance, through which we gain forgiveness of our sins. We need that both as individuals and as a country. How have our own behaviors fed the divisions in this country? How can we change those behaviors to bring about healing?

This year Ash Wednesday falls on February 17. (It is always 40 days before Easter, not counting Sundays – because every Sunday is a mini celebration of Easter.) Because of the pandemic, we will not have our traditional Ash Wednesday service. Instead we will have a drive-through imposition of ashes (with appropriate sanitizing) in the alley between the church and the Family Life Center. You can “attend” between 9:30 and 10:30 a.m., between noon and 1 p.m., or between 5 and 6 p.m. Please enter the alley from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street.

Ash Wednesday also marks the beginning of Lent, traditionally a time of self-reflection and repentance. Recent months awakened in many of us the need for more diligent, honest, and critical self-reflection, as well as repentance. It has been humbling, informative, and painful to see how divided we are as a nation. May Lent allow us to repent of any behaviors that may have led to this division. (I cannot think of anything more important to give up for Lent than those behaviors.) You know the repentance drill: Stop doing the wrong thing, and start doing the right thing!

Even Valentine’s Day – essentially just a marketing ploy – gives us the opportunity to improve. Depending on where we are in life, it reminds us of the love we have or the lack thereof. Being reminded of love, being encouraged to love, is never a bad thing.

For Christians, loving others is not optional, as the Scripture above makes clear. It is no accident that Jesus used this language. We may be able to choose our associates, but rarely can we choose our neighbors. While recent events have made us aware that our neighbors may be more diverse than we assumed, Jesus’ message is the same: Love them all (and, yes, all means all) and let God sort them out.

So, as we look to the future, may we commit ourselves anew to self-reflection, to repentance, and to loving our neighbors.




## ADULT MINISTRIES

At the end of November, we were in the negative by \$44,391. I appealed to each of you to pray about our finances and, if possible, give a little extra in the month of December. To say that I am amazed at the response would be an understatement! Our church has a reputation of closing well and we certainly did that in 2020. In fact, if you include the more than \$266,000 in directed gifts for the refurbishment of the altar, carpets, pews, plumbing repairs, FLC roof replacement, scholarships, Meridian Foodbank, COVID relief, mission trips, etc., total support of God's work at the Church of the Warm Heart totals more than \$1,000,000. Thank you for your continued support!

We are starting 2021 with a surplus of \$20,631. This is a great situation. All of us are glad that 2020 is behind us and hope and pray for many good things ahead in 2021.

Now, for the 2021 budget. The standing committees, staff, and Administrative Council have been very diligent in preparing and approving the new budget. The budget is built with the hopes that we will be able to resume meeting together at some point in 2021! As always, the majority of the budget is to pay the salaries of our dedicated and hard-working staff. The budget figures are below:
